### **Ouestions for Discussion:**

- What is God teaching you through His Holy Spirit?
- What do you notice/like/dislike about these Bible verses?
- What do these Bible verses tell us about people & God?
- What is sin?
- Have you ever sinned? How? Did you realize there is a penalty for your sin?

#### **Think About:**

Just like a teammate has to serve a penalty for the goalie, Jesus came to serve the penalty for your sin.

### **Observations to Consider & Truths to Believe:**

- God is our best coach for life.
- He decided to give His Son, Jesus Christ, to be the perfect and holy sacrifice.
- We can receive the gift of eternal life with God, if we put our trust in Jesus.

# **Key Point:**

God desires a personal relationship with you. He loves you so much that He sent His only Son to pay the penalty for your sin, so you can have a relationship with Him forever.

## Questions to Ask Yourself:

- Have you ever sinned? How? (Be honest with God He already knows!)
- Have you thought about the penalty that sin causes?
- Did you know that Jesus willingly served that penalty for you?
- Have you accepted this incredible gift of forgiveness and eternal life that Jesus has given you? Why or why not?

## **Action Steps:**

- Admit you have sinned and need forgiveness. Spend some time telling God specifically how you have sinned and that you are heartbroken about your sin.
- · Believe that God's Son, Jesus Christ, died as the personal substitute for your sin, and rose again from the grave defeating sin and death.
- Commit to turning away from your sins and turn back to God, to love and serve Him.
- Pray a sincere prayer to God, about your sin and thanking Him for this incredible gift.
